**Q: Who are the Faculty/Major advisors?**

A: Professor Edith Wolfe.

**Q: Where do students often study abroad?**

A: Students regularly study in Argentina and Chile and we are seeing more of them study in Brazil and Mexico.

**Q: What classes can students take within this major to fill the public service requirement?**

A: LAST 1010/1020 and 2 special topics political science classes offered once a year.

**Q: Does TU have a graduate program in this area? Does your office have information on grad programs at other schools?**

A: Yes, a masters and a Ph.D program. Also a 5th year cooperative with Georgetown no GRE test is required to apply. Students take 3 undergraduate classes towards the masters.

**Q: Are there any clubs affiliated with this program?**

A: TULASO – Tulane Undergraduate Latin American Studies Organization is the only club affiliated with the undergraduate program.

**Q: Are there any places around the city that you would recommend for students to continue learning outside the class room?**

A: Students teach English as a Second Language through Catholic Charities.

**Q: What is the process for declaring majors/minors?**

A: Complete declaration form and meet with Professor Wolfe.

**Q: What is the process for transfer credit?**

A: As long as 25% of the content is LAST, it will transfer. No language. Submit signed Transfer Credit Approval form (academic advisor's signature) to Professor Wolfe.

**Q: Where do students find forms and to whom can we send electronic forms?**

A: Students can get forms from AAC or the office of Latin American Studies. Electronic forms can be sent to Professor Wolfe.
