Q: Who are the Faculty/Major advisors?

A: Dr. Mary Blue

Q: What is the process for declaring majors/minors?

A: Students should complete a Major/Minor Declaration form and email Dr. Blue to set up an appointment to have it signed.

Q: Where do students often study abroad?

A: Students study in Europe, Latin America, and Australia primarily.

Q: What classes can students take within this major to fill the public service requirement?

Q: What internships/work study/summer programs do you know about?

A: The Contemporary Hollywood Film Program is a 6-credit summer course that features a trip to Hollywood.
