**Q: Who are the Faculty/Major advisors?**

A: Students must submit the signed Transfer Credit Approval form (academic advisor's signature), syllabus, and course description to Professor Crawford. Core classes cannot be transferred.

A: The major/minor does not require students to study abroad but for those students interested in studying abroad, they usually do so through the Center for Global Education.

**Q: What classes can students take within this major to fill the public service requirement?**
